I don't have any information about place of birth. Michael could have been born in Germany. He was a good friend of George Wiedemann the man who started Wiedemann's Brewery in Newport in 1870. I thought perhaps they came from Germany together. Michael Schraffenberger was a business man. He had a boarding house on East Riverside Drive. He also owned a large house at 602 East Riverside Drive on the cornor of Linden Avenue. He gave it to his daughter Magdalena as a wedding present. I have since found out he and his family were in the meat packing business in Cincinnati, Ohio
I'm not sure of the dates of Michael and his wife's birth, marriage, or deaths or how many children they had. They are buried in Spring Hill Cemetery in Cincinnati, Ohio.

Magdalena was born November 16, 1854 - died October 2,1942 at the age of 88 at her home, 602 East Riverside Drive Newport

George Henn was born October 6th 1847

She bought her return ticket for Newport on May 22, 1906 and
she came home to confort her Mother Magdalena and the rest
of her family after her father death.
Magdalena carried on bravely. She spoke German fluently and

Magdalena carried on bravely. She spoke German fluently and her broken English was charming spiced with a heavy accent. The children understood German and spoke German when they didn't want their children to know who or what they were talking about.

They didn't have a German accent, however they clung to their heritage and the strong German work ethic, stoicism combined with family loyality and love and trust in God.

Grandmother Henn was educated in an Academy established by the German Lutheran Church. The Academy was located either at their church or close to the Church on Seventh and Columbia Street in Newport, Kentucky.

I haven't learn much about Magdalena's mother or that generation. George Henn's family is a mystery to me as well.

Her whole family attended St John's throughout the years. Her parents were probably married in the Church when it was a Lutheran Church. (Speculation on my part)

Magdalena and George were married April 26th 1876. She had a wide gold wedding band probably given to her by her Father. It is engraved from C. Sch to M. Sch 1875. I think it must have been an anniversary gift given to Michael by Magdalena's Mother. (possible their 25th anniversary) Her Mother may have died the shortly after their anniversary.

Magdalena and George Henn had six living children. They may have lost a child who died at an early age and perhaps others that I am not aware of.
